



As Reported by Ramy:

There were 10 flights from Truckee to Shasta and beyond, by more than 5 pilots, some of them having 2 Shasta flights! This is like 10 times the average of one Shasta flight per season. We also had at least that number of flights to Whitney and beyond. We had flights north into Oregon, south to beyond Whitney, east to Austin and West across the Sierras to Byron. TTSA (Soar Truckee) Mentoring Program:


