

Alby's Voyage - Statistics

- The straight distance from Bodega Bay to Kitty Hawk is about 2,600 miles.
- The distance measured in the 23 segments from glider site to glider site is about 3640 miles and the distance actually flown by glider is perhaps 20% more so about 4,370 miles.
- The longest flight was 305 miles, the shortest 23 miles
- Highest altitude of 18,000'. The lowest altitude was 210' (below sea level) when landing in Furnace Creek, Death Valley, CA.
